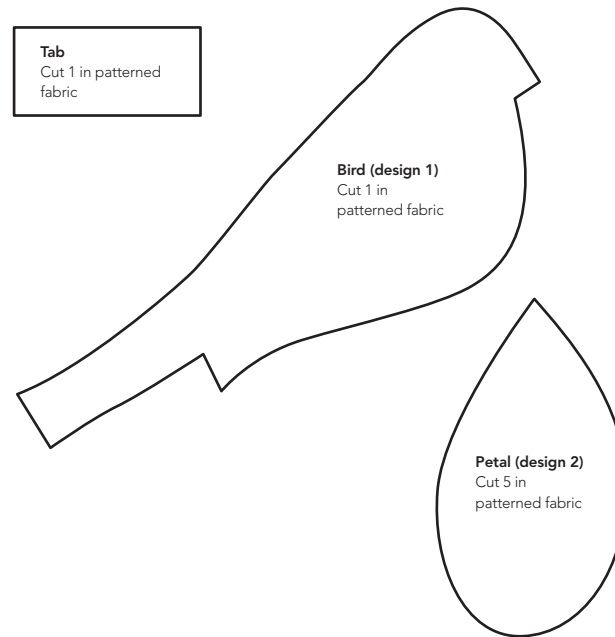
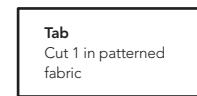
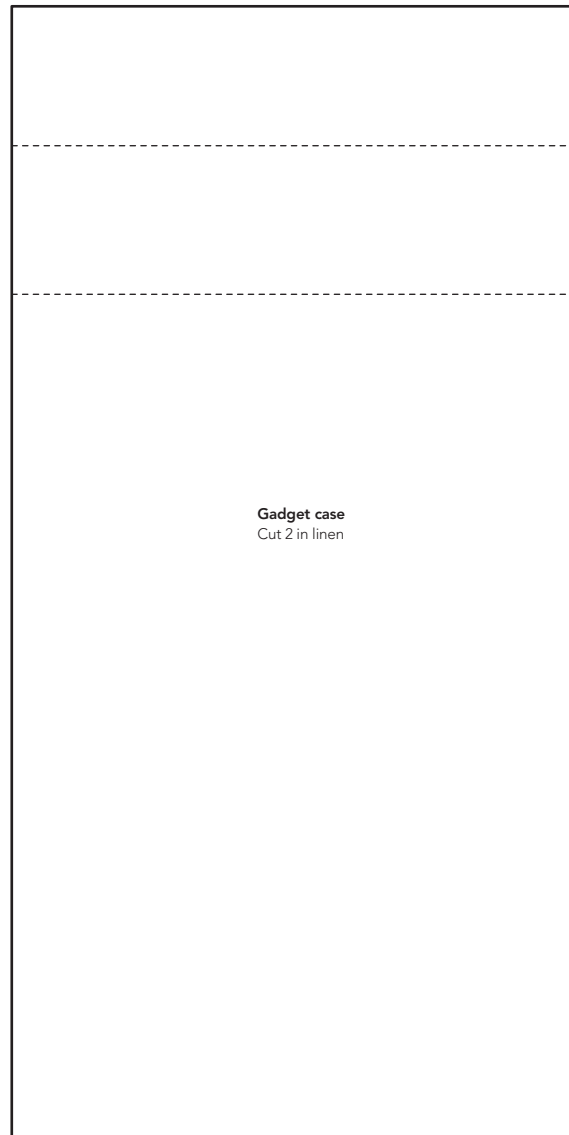

# LINEN GADGET COSY

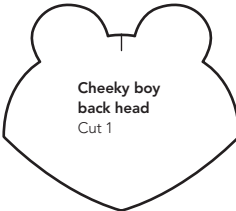
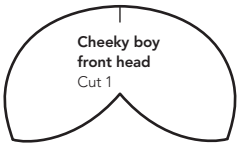
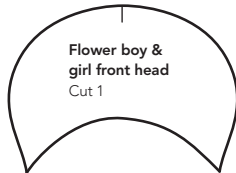
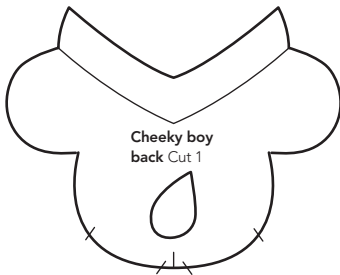
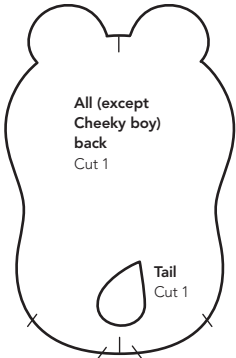
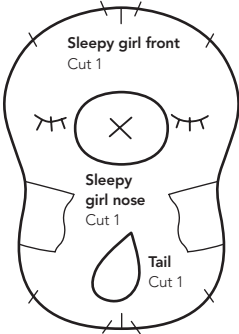
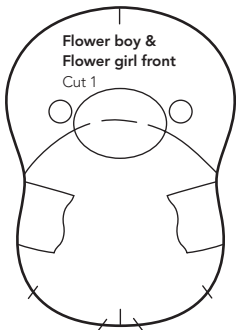
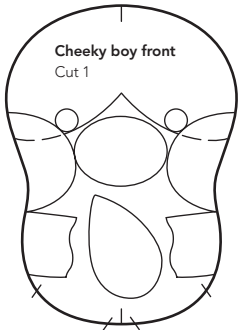

## HOW TO MAKE:

- 01 Trace the templates of the bird (or petals), the rectangle and the tab onto your patterned fabric and cut them out carefully. You can also cut around one of the flowers in the fabric's pattern.
- 02 Now start on the main part of the case by cutting two rectangles from the linen. Appliqué the patterned fabric rectangle onto one of the linen pieces with the top of the fabric sitting 1cm above the bottom folding guide (shown by a dotted line in the template).
- 03 Fold the top of the linen over the patterned fabric along the top folding guide, leaving 1cm of the patterned fabric showing. Sew around the three raw edges of the linen flap to secure it. This will be the front side of your case.
- 04 Appliqué the bird and the flower onto the linen. Using the red embroidery thread, stitch a branch effect and sew the button to the top of your case.
- 05 On the second piece of linen, fold over the flap using the template guide lines and sew it down as in Step 3 (this time without the patterned fabric).
- 06 Place the right sides of the linen together. Now fold the tab fabric in half, wrong sides together. Position it between the two pieces of linen near the bottom of the case, with raw edges together.
- 07 Pin the linen and tab together, and backstitch from below the top flaps all the way around the three raw edges. Now turn your gadget case right side out, decide which gadget to put in your cosy and you're ready to go!
